

- Blacklist



Desegregation in the Military

- Truman ordered the desegregation of the U.S. armed forces in 1948
- Brought black and white Americans together in the close confines of the U.S. military

Desegregation in Sports

- Jackie Robinson
- First African American inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame

Brown v. Board

- Supreme Court ruled that separate educational facilities for black and white people were "inherently unequal"

1954	Ray Kroc buys the small-scale franchise McDonald's Restaurant and begins to turn it into the most successful fast-food chain in the world.
1959	The Beatles form.
